

Sejha għal Espressjoni ta' Interess għall-Għoti ta' Korsijiet fil-Letteratura Maltija u l-Kritika Letterarja għal Studenti tal-10 Sena

Introduzzjoni

L-Aġenzija Nazzjonali tal-Litteriżmu tistieden individwi kwalifikati biex jesprimu l-interess tagħhom li jipprovdu s-servizz ta' tutor għal Award Mhux Formali akkreditat **fil-Letteratura Malti u l-Kritika Letterarja (MQF Livell 3)**. - jipprovdi feedback dwar ix-xogħol tal-istudenti u jsegwi l-progress tagħhom;
- iżomm rekords ta' attendenza u kwalunkwe dokumentazzjoni meħtieġa mill-Aġenzija Nazzjonali tal-Litteriżmu;
- jipparteċipa fil-proċessi interni ta' monitoraġġ u assigurazzjoni tal-kwalità stabbiliti mill-Aġenzija Nazzjonali tal-Litteriżmu;
- jgħin lill-istudenti permezz ta' komunikazzjoni u gwida kontinwa matul il-kors;

2. Ikollhom esperjenza ta' almenu ħames snin bħala għalliema tal-Malti b'mod partikulari tal-letteratura Maltija u l-kritika letterarja fil-livell sekondarju; u
3. Ikollhom ħiliet ta' livell għoli fil-komunikazzjoni miktuba u mitkellma bil-Malti; u
4. Jipprezentaw ċertifikat validu tal-kondotta; u
5. Ikunu lesti li jsegwu l-politiki, proċeduri u linji gwida kollha maħruġa mill-Aġenzija Nazzjonali tal-Litteriżmu matul il-perjodu kollu tal-kuntratt.

Call for Expression of Interest for the Provision of Courses in Maltese Literature and Literary Criticism for Students in Year 10

Expression of Interest (Ref. 26/225)

Introduction

The National Literacy Agency invites qualified individuals to express their interest in providing tutoring services for the accredited **Non-formal Award in Maltese Literature and Literary Criticism (MQF Level 3)**. The courses are aimed at Year 10 students and will each be delivered online through twelve one-hour synchronous sessions using MS Teams. The selected tutor/s shall support learners in developing literary appreciation, practical criticism skills, and analytical writing competencies in Maltese literature. The courses will be delivered between October 2026 and February 2027. Courses are to be delivered in the afternoons, after 5pm.

Duties and Responsibilities

The service is being requested on a contract-for-service basis.

The selected tutor shall be responsible for:

- planning, preparing, organising and delivering online lessons in accordance with the approved course specification;
- delivering high-quality teaching in Maltese literature and literary criticism;
- preparing lesson materials, presentations, and learning resources as required;
- providing feedback on students' work and monitoring their progress;
- maintaining attendance records and any documentation required by the National Literacy Agency;
- participating in internal monitoring and quality assurance processes established by the Agency;
- supporting students through ongoing communication and guidance during the course;
- adhering to all policies, procedures, safeguarding requirements and standards established by the National Literacy Agency;
- submitting reports, timesheets and any other documentation requested by the Agency within established deadlines.

Remuneration

Tutors shall be remunerated at €22 per hour of lesson delivery and €22 per hour for preparation and/or feedback provision, with one paid preparation/feedback hour allocated for every hour of delivery.

Payment shall be effected upon submission of the appropriate timesheet and invoice, together with any supporting documentation requested by the Agency.

Eligibility Criteria

Applicants must:

1. Hold a recognised Bachelor's Degree in Maltese (MQF Level 6) or higher; OR a recognised Teaching Degree with Maltese as the principal/main area of study at MQF Level 6, or higher; AND
2. Have at least five years' experience teaching Maltese, particularly Maltese literature and literary criticism, at secondary level; AND
3. Possess strong written and spoken communication skills in Maltese; AND
4. Submit a valid Conduct Certificate; AND
5. Be willing to adhere to all policies, procedures and guidelines issued by the National Literacy Agency throughout the duration of the engagement.

Preference may be given to applicants who:

- possess postgraduate qualifications in Maltese Literature or Education;
- have experience delivering online learning programmes.

Costs

Any expenses incurred by applicants in connection with this Expression of Interest shall be borne entirely by the applicants. The National Literacy Agency shall not be responsible for any costs associated with the preparation or submission of applications.

Submission Requirements

Applicants must submit:

- a letter expressing their interest;
- a Europass Curriculum Vitae;
- copies of relevant qualifications and certificates;
- a valid Conduct Certificate;
- any documentation demonstrating relevant teaching or tutoring experience.

Only complete applications received by the closing date will be considered.

Successful applicants may be engaged according to operational requirements and subject to the needs of the accredited programme.
